**Leadline** - Open to riders 7 years of age and under as of 12/1/19. Riders may not cross enter into any class where they would be asked to trot.

**Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation** – Open to riders 10 years and under as of 12/1/19. Riders may not cross enter into any classes where they would be asked to canter or jump.

**Short Stirrup Equitation** – Open to riders 12 years and under as of 12/1/19. Judged on equitation. Riders may not cross enter into classes where they would jump over 18". May trot fences.

**Long Stirrup** - Open to riders 13 and older. Riders may not cross enter into classes where they would jump over 18". May trot fences.

**Student Equitation** – Open to riders in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2'0" or higher as of 12/1/19. Riders competing in the Student Equitation Division are limited to two years only, whether they compete over fences or not. Judged on equitation. Courses may be trotted. Fences: 2'0".

**Pleasure Pony** – Open to ponies ridden by Juniors. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness, and way of going.

**Pony Hunter** – Open to ponies ridden by Juniors. The division will be split to small/medium and large ponies if entries warrant. Fences: Small 2'0", Medium 2'3", Large 2'6". \* May be split if entries warrant.

**Green Pony Hunter** – Open to ponies in their first year of showing at regulation heights as of 12/1/19 ridden by Juniors. Fences: Small 2'0", Medium 2'3", Large 2'6". \* May be split if entries warrant.

VHSA/BHSA Pony Equitation – Open to ponies ridden by Juniors. Fences: Small 2'0", Medium 2'3", Large 2'6" or 2'9". The judge may select at least ¼ of the class to show at the walk/trot/canter and to perform additional tests at the judge's discretion.

**Equitation on the Flat**—Open to juniors on horses or ponies, and adult amateurs on horses or ponies not entered in a pony division. To be shown at walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. Test 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences.\*May be split:Juniors(14&under), Juniors(15-17), and Adults, if entries warrant.

**Pleasure Horse** – Open to any horse. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness, and way of going. \* May be split: Junior and Adult, if entries warrant.

**Maiden Hunter** – Open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing over fences at 2' or higher as of 12/1/19. No restrictions on riders. May trot fences.

Limit Rider Hunter – Open to horses and ponies ridden by Juniors and Adult Amateurs who are not entered in any classes jumping 2'6" or higher. These riders are not eligible for AA Equitation, Pony Equitation, or Jr./Children's Equitation. Ponies must be ridden by juniors. Horses and ponies may cross enter into other divisions. Courses to be a minimum of 6 fences set at 2' or 2'3". Can be combined only with Low Hunter and/or Maiden Hunter.

**Low Hunter** – Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fences: 2'0" or 2'3".

**Josephine Mysliwski Memorial Hunter Derby** – Open to Junior and Adult Amateurs only. Fence heights are rider's choice @ 2', 2'6", or 3'. Rounds are scored and the top 12 are invited back for a second round. Ribbons and cash prizes are awarded through 10<sup>th</sup> place.

**Green Hunter** – Open to horses in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2'6" or higher as of 12/1/19. Fences: 2'6".

**Thoroughbred Hunter** – Open to Thoroughbreds registered with the Jockey Club or eligible to be registered. Fences: 2'6".

**Working Hunter** – Open to all horses and ponies not entered in a pony division. May be split if entries warrant. Fences: 2'6', 2'9" or 3'0" (Only 2'9" and 3' are recognized by BHSA)

VHSA/BHSA Children's/Adult Amateur Equitation – Open to horses ridden by Juniors and Adult Amateurs. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a pony division. Fences: 2'6" or 3'0".

The judge may select at least ¼ of the class to show at the walk/trot/canter and to perform additional tests at the judge's discretion. \* May be split if entries warrant.

**Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter** – Open to horses ridden by Juniors and Adult Amateurs. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a pony division. Fences: 2'6" or 3'0". \* May be split if entries warrant.

Please park your trailers on the gravel areas to avoid getting stuck. Due to staffing we may be unavailable to pull out any vehicles that get stuck. There is a \$50 fee if we are available to pull your vehicle out.

All Hunter classes will be judged on performance; including way of going, jumping style and soundness. Manners and suitability will be emphasized in Pony, Children's and Adult Amateur Hunter classes.

All Equitation classes will be judged on hands, seat, guidance, and control.

You may join or renew your BHSA and/or your VHSA Memberships at the Secretary Stand. Please be prepared to pay with a check. Cash will not be accepted for membership fees.

## Points will count from December 13, 2020 THROUGH OCTOBER 17, 2021.

#### **SHOW RULES**

- 1. **ASTM/SEI certified helmets must be worn by ALL RIDERS when mounted**. Proper attire is required. Jackets may be excused by the judge.
- 2. Class Specification Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and regulations of the current BHSA and VHSA rule book, will be conducted and judged accordingly. The judge's decision is always final.
- 3. All exhibitors must be checked in at the in gate when their class is called.
- 4. Pre-entries are \$16.00 per class and \$18.00 per class the day of. Non Showing fee of \$20.00 for the day.
- 5. Entries will not be accepted without the release on the entry form signed.
- 6. All ages are as of December 1, 2020.
- 7. All horses/ponies on show grounds must present a negative coggins test taken within one year for each entry at <u>each</u> horse show. We will not keep coggins on file any longer. **Please email a copy to**<u>hazelwildfarm1897@gmail.com</u> for every show.
- 8. \$50.00 will be charged for returned checks.
- 9. Points will be counted 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, .5, Champion 10, Reserve Champion 6. Point system is in accordance with VHSA bonus point system.
- 10. Show management reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel and/or combine classes if necessary.
- 11. Exhibitors show at their own risk.
- 12. Lunging is permitted only in the ring near the entrance to the farm.
- 13. Schooling will be allowed in the ring at designated times. Show management reserves the right to split or to terminate schooling.
- 14. Food will be available on the grounds.
- 15. Hazelwild Farm Educational Foundation, any officials, and employees related to the foundation, and its board of directors, will not be held responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectator, groom, property, or animal at the show.
- 16. Participants and spectators alike understand that horses are inherently unpredictable and dangerous and that equipment and ground conditions are equally unpredictable; and knowingly choose to participate and/or spectate, taking full responsibility for this choice. Entry onto the grounds constitutes knowledge and agreement with this policy.

Pre entries are due five days prior to the show. Entries need to be emailed to HAZELWILDFARM1897@GMAIL.COM. Late entries may not be accepted due to class sizes. No entries will be accepted the day of the show. Entry forms are available at: <a href="https://www.hazelwildfarm.com">www.hazelwildfarm.com</a>

Forms need to be completed with signatures and submitted via email only. Entries will not be considered until we have received ALL completed forms.

A complete entry includes:

- a. Entry Form
- b. Coggins
- c. Hazelwild Farm Waiver Release
- d. Hazelwild Farm Virus Participant Release (\*Adult/Minor)
- \*(d.) The Virus Participant Release is for everyone on the show grounds, not only riders (parents and trainers). There are separate forms for minors and adults.

Please limit the number of people using secretary services (i.e. one person per barn) to pick up your barn's packet. Each barn or individual will receive a packet with disposable numbers, courses and Covid policy. Packets can be found outside the outdoor secretary stand.

When you are done, please place your check or exact change in the given packet and place the packet at the box with Teresa (near the in-gate). Please ensure that everyone's money from your farm is in the packet before dropping it off. Checks should be made out to Hazelwild Farm. If you plan to pay in cash, please bring exact change. No change will be given.

Scratches will be allowed the day of the show and no new entries will be accepted.

Courses will be posted on the Hazelwild Farm's Facebook page prior to the show and included in each barn/individual packet.

Based on pre entries, we will determine the number and times of schooling breaks. Schooling breaks will be for the people in that division only, unless you ask permission. This information will be on Facebook by noon the day before the show. Please use the outdoor ring to flat prior to your schooling break to promote efficiency. The jump heights will be set so there will be no touching the jumps by anyone who is not horse show staff.

No ribbons will be distributed at the ring. Please keep track of your awards. Ribbons will be outside next to the secretary stand. Please grab them as you leave.

Show will be held in the indoor ring only. Doors will be open and fans will be on for ventilation. There is a hose available for rinsing horses and water located outside of the indoor near the new bathrooms. The barns and wash stalls are closed to all exhibitors. No stall rentals will be available.

Only riders and trainers will be permitted on the in-gate side of the arena. We realize parents need to be present on the grounds for minors, but please limit the number of parents or guardians to one per child. Please watch your child only from the viewing

area and then exit the indoor. Siblings, friends, or other spectators will not be permitted on the show grounds.

When outside, all present on the show grounds, whether part of the show, guest, or boarder at the facility, will be required to wear masks or face coverings if within 6ft of another person not within your family unit.

All that enter the indoor must wear a mask, even if you are maintaining six feet of distance. While riding, masks are not required, however there will not be a penalty for wearing one.

Dogs must be kept under control and confined or leashed at all times. Dogs can potentially come in contact with multiple people if loose on competition grounds. They must be confined and/or leashed away from the general public. If a dog is found loose on competition grounds, the owner and dog will be expelled from the grounds immediately.

When not competing, please remain at your trailer maintaining proper social distancing from others. No gathering in large groups near or away from the competition ring. Once you have finished competing, please depart the grounds in a timely manner.

The bathrooms will be open and hand wipe stations at the secretary stand and ring side. Please dispose of all trash in the trash cans provided.

Trainers and/or barns are subject to expulsion from the grounds if guidelines are not followed. Please discuss with each individual in your group the importance of following rules and the direction of horse show staff. **GUIDELINES**:

The following COVID-19 Guidelines must be adhered to when competing and/or attending our competitions. In addition, all Federal, State, and local laws that may be applicable must be followed. Management reserves the right to change the guidelines when/if it is necessary. Failure to follow guidelines may result in expulsion from the show grounds. The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to the virus.

If you plan to come to the competition grounds, you must be able to assure management that neither you, nor anyone in your household:

- 1. Has tested positive or has been presumed positive for COVID-19 at any time during the past 14 days
- 2. Has been advised by a healthcare professional to self-quarantine at any time during the past 14 days
- 3. Has been in close physical contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID 19 or who has been presumed positive for COVID-19, during the past 14 days
- 4. Is subject to a quarantine order or a recommendation of a healthcare professional that, in either case, would make it inadvisable to attend a public event or competition.
- 5. Has, within the past 24 hours, exhibited any of the following symptoms: fever of 100.4 or greater, cough, shortness of breath. Please adhere to all social distancing guidelines and be mindful of your surroundings. We are all in this together and need to all do our part to make this day safe for all.
