### ***The School***

The Hazelwild Farm Educational Foundation is located on an ancestral homestead. Ms. A. Elizabeth Morrison established this non-profit foundation to continue her lifelong career of education and care for young children. The foundation and its board of directors are responsible for the operation of the school and a summer camp program. These programs have been in continuous operation since 1960. Children who attend any of our programs have an opportunity to observe farm life and to learn in an operating farm environment.

While the school is licensed by the Social Services Department as a Day Care Center, we like to consider ourselves a little more. We offer a structured learning program with frequent periods of relaxation and coordinated activities geared to the age and ability of the individual child.

We invite you to make an appointment to visit our facilities and meet our staff.

#### ***School Philosophy***

We strive for the harmonious development of your child in a stimulating but relaxed atmosphere, with a wholesome outdoor setting away from the hustle and bustle of the city yet within a few minutes drive from the city.

## *Curriculum*

Our Kindergarten program utilizes a developmental approach, which includes the emotional, social, physical and academic well being of each child. Throughout the calendar year both seasonal and traditional school theme units are introduced. Each idea is adapted to be developmentally appropriate for the kindergarten age group. Learning occurs through socialization with others, songs and finger plays, small and large group experiences, interactive play through classroom centers, and fine and gross motor activities. We provide special classes each week in Spanish, Music, Library/Media and Physical Education.

### *Enrollment Criteria*

Our Kindergarten program is designed for children 5 years of age. It is a requirement that your child be 5 by September 30<sup>th</sup> to be a candidate for enrollment in the kindergarten program. **All students must be toilet trained and able to take care of their own hygiene needs.**

Every child must also have a complete and **up-to-date file including application form, registration fee, physical and immunization forms and birth certificate.**

Our enrollment is limited. When a child's application is approved, he/she is accepted for the fall school session. To complete the application process the custodial

parent must read, sign and be willing to abide by the Hazelwild Country Day School's Student Handbook and this brochure.

### *The Teaching Staff*

Our teaching staff is professionally prepared with experience in both public and private schools. All of the teachers have extensive training in the field of early childhood education and child development. Every member of the staff carries on our school philosophy and treats each child with care and respect.

### *Fundraising*

Hazelwild will hold at least five fundraisers per school year. These fundraisers help to offset rising insurance premiums and enable us to keep tuition costs down. **Enthusiastic participation is required in order for fundraising to be effective in controlling costs.**

### *Rates*

School tuition is divided into monthly payments coinciding with the school term, August through May. All rates apply to both full day and half day kindergarten classes. Tuition is due the first of each month. Rates are adjusted accordingly

#### *Monthly Late Fee Rates*

#### **Registration Fee and June Tuition**

The registration fee is **\$65.00 for new students and \$55.00 for returning students.** This fee should accompany all

applications. The registration fee becomes **non-refundable** once the application is accepted. If for any reason the application is not accepted, the registration fee will be returned. **A pro-rated May 2021 tuition has been assigned to your class. This amount must be paid in full by July 1, 2020. Your August tuition is also pro-rated and will be due August 1, 2020.** There is a sibling discount of \$10.00 per month for the second child
